On the date of the hearing there will be a link, towards the top center of the page, referencing the hearing and a green link that reads "live web cast". By clicking on the "live web cast" link, you will be taken to the live web cast of the hearing. The official title of the hearing is "The Impact of Railroad Injury, Accident, and Discipline Policies on the Safety of America's Railroads". The hearing begins at 10:00 a.m. eastern time on Thursday, October 25, 2007.

We believe members of various unions and carrier officials will be questioned by Members of Congress on this issue based on your questions on that date. Speak now or forever hold your peace.
